All arrangements for accommodations at Antiochian Village must be made through our DOK Registrar. Please do NOT contact Antiochian Village for registration.

Handicapped-accessible rooms are available. Please indicate on your registration if you use a wheelchair or walker or are otherwise unable to navigate stairs so we can assign a proper room. Elevators give handicap access to meeting and dining rooms. Please also notify the Registrar about any other special needs.

Check-in for our Assembly/Retreat will open at 3:00 pm on Friday. Rooms also will be available at that time. Meals will begin with dinner on Friday evening at 6:00 pm. Meals also include breakfast, lunch and dinner on Saturday, Sunday breakfast and snacks.

Anyone arriving by air or by train will be met at the airport or train station by a local Daughter of the King and will be escorted to and from Antiochian Village.

RATES

Room rates include room and board. A \$50.00 registration fee is added for each adult to cover materials and expenses for the retreat.

Rates per Senior Daughter:

Single Occupancy: \$311.44 (\$261.44 + \$50)

Double Occupancy: \$237.32 (\$187.32 + \$50)

Triple Occupancy: \$213.34 (\$163.34 + \$50)

Quad Occupancy: \$200.26 (\$150.26 + \$50)

Note: Room rates are based on the number of adults in the room, and every junior must have her own senior sponsor even if it is not her mother, e.g., if a Senior DOK shares a room with a Junior DOK, the Junior would be free but the Senior would pay a single occupancy rate. Two Senior DOK's sharing a room could have up to two Junior DOK's in the room with them and still pay the double occupancy rate. The juniors both would be free.
