Becoming a Christian in his teens, he began to take seriously the Lordship of Jesus, eventually marrying the daughter of an Episcopal priest and investing heavily in the life of the Church. In 1999, Jay was called to leave his career as a disability advocate in Washington D.C. to pursue full-time ministry. He attended TSM in Ambridge while working as a youth minister at Prince of Peace in Hopewell from 1999-2003. After being ordained in 2003, Jay and his wife Catherine and daughters moved to Hilton Head, S.C. where they served as church planters until July 2007. In the summer of 2007, Jay and his family began the work of Jonah's Call starting a new church in Pittsburgh. In April 2008, Jonah's call was launched with Jay as pastor.*
